[11] REGULATION (EU) 2016/679 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of April 27, 2016 on the protection of natural persons in the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, which repeals Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation); consolidated wording

## Article 18 Right to restriction of processing

- 1. The data subject has the right for the operator to restrict processing in one of the following cases: a) the data subject contests the correctness of the personal data during the period allowing the operator to verify the accuracy of the personal data; b) the processing is illegal and the data subject objects to the erasure of personal data and requests a restriction of their use instead; c) the operator no longer needs the personal data for processing purposes, but the data subject needs them to prove, exercise or defend legal claims; d) the person concerned has objected to the processing according to Article 21 paragraph 1, until it is verified whether the legitimate reasons on the part of the operator prevail over the legitimate reasons of the person concerned.
- 2. If the processing has been restricted according to paragraph 1, such personal data, with the exception of storage, are processed only with the consent of the person concerned or for proving, exercising or defending legal claims, or for the protection of the rights of another natural or legal person, or for reasons of important public interest of the Union or a member state.
- 3. The operator informs the affected person who has reached the restriction of processing according to paragraph 1 before by how the restriction of processing will be lifted.
